## **PROGRAM DESCRIPTION**

#### Early Childhood Teacher Education Program

The Early Childhood Teacher Education Program prepares students to become employed in the early childhood field through a variety of courses that are essential to the success as an early childhood educator. Courses in this degree program include childhood development, instructional strategies, academic skills, general education, special education, and classroom management.

#### \* The Associate of Applied Science in Early Childhood Teacher Education does not meet the requirements of teacher licensure.

For students who plan to continue their early childhood education for educator licensure (PreK-5) at a four-year institution, the Early Childhood Teacher Education Program provides a solid base of coursework for transfer. If the goal is to teach at the middle school or high school levels, students are encouraged to meet with an academic adviser regarding appropriate course work.
