Equine Health & Complementary Therapies Program

The Equine Health and Complementary Therapies Program focuses on the health care component of the horse industry. The program was developed to meet the industry demand for qualified horse care technicians.

Students will develop skills in traditional health care such as nutrition, anatomy and physiology, broodmare and foal management, and non-traditional complementary therapies.

In addition to traditional health care, Hocking College's program includes the disciplines of equine massage and acupressure. This unique component teaches students proper massage techniques for applying pressure to and kneading muscles that are prone to fatigue and stress.
