### PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

### **Physical Therapist Assistant Program**

Physical therapist assistants are healthcare providers who work under the supervision of a licensed physical therapist to restore function when disease or injury results in pain and limited movement.

Physical therapy intervention can also prevent further injury. When a patient seeks physical therapy services, the physical therapist performs an initial evaluation and develops a plan of care. The physical therapist assistant carries out the plan of care and reports the patient's response to the supervising physical therapist.

### **DEGREE TRACK**

The listed degree track is for students beginning classes in May 2022 who will pursue an Associate of Applied Science in Physical Therapist Assistant.

The Physical Therapist Assistant program is a selective admissions program. Students are accepted into the Associate of Science program and are required to completed courses listed under Autumn 1 prior to receiving acceptance into the PTA program.

The AS program is a pathway to the selective admission program and allows the student to complete general education requirements. Upon successful completion of all selective admission requirements and acceptance into the technical/clinical portion of the program, the student's academic program will be changed to selective admission program.
