Sports Management Program

Hocking College's Sports Management program prepares students for many entry-level jobs in the sport and athletic industry including sports business, sports administration, sports marketing, sports communication, sports facilities management, and sports entertainment. The degree also serves as a pathway for students to continue their education to earn an advanced degree in Sports Management.



The curriculum focuses on preparing students to work in sports organizations

at the local, collegiate, and professional levels. The program provides students with an education that features real-world amateur and professional sports experiences and interactions with professionals in the industry. In addition to business concepts and theories, students will learn new perspectives and skills in athlete, facilities, and project management, as well as problem-solving, leadership, and ethical decision-making.

TRANSFER PATHWAYS

Hocking College provides students with the foundation and experiences they need to successfully enter the workforce or transfer to a four-year university. Transfer admission is guaranteed to any public four-year university in Ohio for in-state residents who have earned an associate degree from Hocking College.

Hocking College is also accredited by the Higher Learning Commission as a quality standard that assures Hocking credits will transfer. In fact, formal articulation agreements are in place for more than 30 academic programs.

In addition, Hocking College offers a complete set of general education requirements that are guaranteed to transfer to any Ohio public colleges and universities as part of the Ohio Transfer Module (OTM).
