PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Wildlife Resources Management Program

The Wildlife Resources Management Program at Hocking College is a hands-on, experience-based curriculum where students actively learn and practice field skills which include wildlife, fish and plant field and lab identification; wildlife field data collection techniques such as survey, capture, radio telemetry, habitat and population sampling; and other general field skills such as GPS-GIS duties, map-making and natural resources equipment operation.



In addition, students leave the program with a strong conceptual understanding of wildlife management, ecology, and conservation, as well as botany and plant ecology and identification, and natural resources as a whole.

The Wildlife Resources Management degree is designed for students interested primarily in seeking employment in fish and wildlife careers after acquiring their two-year associate degree. Most positions with county and state parks, and the Ohio Division of Wildlife, require a two-year wildlife degree.
