Hocking College is responsible to its students and taxpayers for the appropriate and effective use of its facilities. The college shall allocate these resources for college and community functions that advance the college's mission. No person or organization shall be excluded from rental or use of college facilities based on age, ancestry, color, disability, gender identity or expression, genetic information, military status, national origin, race, religion, sex, sexual orientation, or veteran status.

Alcohol is prohibited in college owned or leased buildings, or on college owned or leased grounds and parking lots, unless authorized by the President for an event, or purchased for resale by a college auxiliary enterprise appropriate liquor permits are the responsibility of the lesson when not served in compliance with a Hocking College liquor permit.

The President may waive provisions of this policy or related procedures if doing so will advance the college's mission and is in compliance with state and federal laws.

The Office of Facilities and Administrative Services shall establish procedures to administer this policy.
