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**Policy Title:** Tobacco–Free Campus Policy

Hocking College strives to enhance the general health and wellbeing of its faculty, staff, students, and visitors. To support this commitment, the College provides a tobacco free environment. Smoking and the use of tobacco are prohibited in or on all college owned, operated, or leased property including vehicles.

Tobacco is defined as all tobacco-derived or containing products, including and not limited to, cigarettes (e.g., clove, bidis, kreteks), electronic cigarettes, cigars and cigarillos, hookah smoked products, pipes, and oral tobacco (e.g., spit and spitless, smokeless, chew, snuff) and nasal tobacco. It also includes any product intended to mimic tobacco products, contain tobacco flavoring, or deliver nicotine other than for the purpose of cessation (e.g., e-cigarettes). Faculty, staff, and students violating this policy are subject to College disciplinary action.

Visitors who violate this policy may be denied access to Hocking College campuses and may ultimately be subject to arrest for criminal trespass.
