## **HC TRIO Exceeds Annual Objectives!!**

The Student Support Services (SSS) program was authorized in 1968 by the Higher Education Act of 1965. The goal of SSS is to increase postsecondary persistence and graduation rates of first-generation college students, and/or low-income students.

Hocking College TRIO staff have been working to meet these goals. An Annual Performance Report is submitted to the U.S. Department of Education every Spring. Ours have been submitted and our hard work has paid off once again. Results are in and the scores reflect the TRIO staff's exemplary work. We are happy to report that we have met and exceeded all objectives!

- We are required to serve 225 Hocking College students, 247 were served.
- The approved objective for persistence from
- autumn 2021 to autumn 2022 was 56 percent, actual rate attained was 83 percent.
- The approved objective for academic standing was 81 percent, actual rate attained was 85
- percent.
- The approved objective for graduation within four years was 16 percent, with an attained rate of 37 percent.
- The approved objective for students to graduate AND transfer to a four year institution is 10
- percent, 13 percent achieved this goal.

Prior Experience Points (PE points) are earned for meeting each objective. These points go toward the next grant competition. The highest available amount is 15 which is based on meeting each objective. We have received all 15 points!


